In 2016 San Juan Headwaters . . .



Offered 21 Outreach Opportunities

Provided information about forest health concerns in the San Juan Mountains and efforts to secure more resilient communities. These events included bringing researchers and practitioners to the region, working with Pagosa Schools to involve students, and offering field

visits to project areas.



The efforts brought nearly 1 million dollars to the area and supported 8 full time jobs. The group supports a buy-local initiative to promote local wood use.



Conducted Work on the Ground

1,900 acres of public lands, 144 acres of private lands, and 60 acres of municipal lands were treated in association with the groups' efforts.

Fire On-the-Ground

Worked with partners to conduct prescribed fire on approximately 600 acres of public lands.

Evaluated and Assessed treatments to assure goals were achieved.
