- Joe: SJWCD just submitted preliminary application for BOR grant. mediation with PAWSD March 13, time to retire 3 board members
- Amanda: Reservoir Hill ranking got funded by National Forest Legacy Foundation, will learn in May if TOPS can move forward. FRWRM \$42,000 to do 10 acres for wildfire mitigation
